## Nurse's Corner

Dear Parents,

Here's hoping that you and your family stay healthy! Unfortunately, we have many out with different illnesses. ☹ Please help us keep our school community healthy by adhering strictly to the WCS Illness Policy. See attached.

Here is what is going around:

- The Flu - Symptoms can include: sudden onset of fever, chills, cough, sore throat, achiness, headache and/or muscle aches. PLEASE check your child's temperature if they wake up with any of these symptoms! They can NOT return to school until they have been fever-free and vomit/diarrhea-free for 24 hours without the use of medications.
- Strep Throat - The only way you can be sure it's not strep is by having your child have a throat culture. Please take them to the doctor if they have had a sore throat for 2 days or more even if they do NOT have a fever.
- Stomach Virus
- Cold Virus
- Head Lice - just a very few cases left.

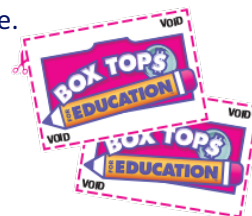

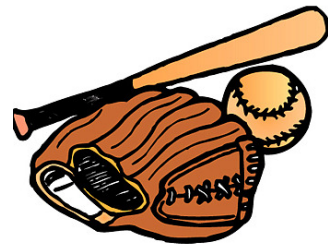
## Extracurriculars
