# Golf Tournament Thank You

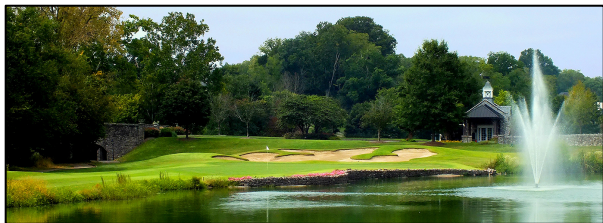

This process may take several weeks, so please plan accordingly. You must bring your driver's license for verification. **No volunteer badge may be made without your driver's license.** If you lost your badge or your badge is broken, you may obtain a replacement badge for \$5 and you must bring your driver's license for verification again.
