# TCAP Testing Begins Next Week!

Students in Grades 3-5 will be taking TN Ready assessments on Tuesday, April 18 – Thursday, April 20, Thursday, April 27 – Friday, April 28, and Tuesday, May 2 – Wednesday, May 3. Please note the following:

- The school will not allow visitors, including classroom volunteers and lunch, on testing days. It is vital that the school maintains a secure testing environment for the entire school day.
- During the assessment windows, family trips for students in grades 3-5 *will not be excused*.
- The state passed a law in which scores will account for 10% of students' 2<sup>nd</sup> semester grades.




# **Student Registration for 2017-18**
