America Recycles Day

Increased Pay for Bus Drivers















In another effort to remedy the bus driver shortage, the School Board recently approved an INCREASE IN THE STARTING PAY for bus drivers from \$14.72/hour to \$17.25/hour, with experienced drivers making up to \$24.05/hour. In September, the School Board approved a pilot program that will allow a limited number of TUITION WAIVERS to school bus drivers who live outside of Williamson County and enroll their children in a Williamson County school.

Become a school bus driver or share this information with someone who may be interested! In addition to the an increased pay and tuition waiver, bus drivers receive FULL BENEFITS and may work as little as 5 hours/day, though additional field trip routes may be available. Bus drivers get summers, holidays, and weekends off and it is work that allows you to be off your feet!
